

DO YOU WANT TO SEE **BETTER DRIVING AT NIGHT?**


This year, Daylight Savings will fall on November 7th, the day we set our clocks back an hour, officially welcoming the season of shorter days. For many, shorter days result in an increase in nighttime driving.

VETERANS DAY

It was at 11:00 AM on November 11, 1918 that a temporary peace, or armistice, was signed & the fighting during World War I came to an end.

A year later, President Woodrow Wilson announced that November 11th would be called Armistice Day in the United States. In 1938, Armistice Day became a national federal holiday. It was a day dedicated to world peace & held in honor of the veterans of World War I.

In 1954, Congress decided to change the day to Veteran's Day because they wanted to honor the veterans of all wars, including World War II & the Korean War.

In 1968, the day was moved to the 4th Monday of November. However, it was changed back to November 11th in 1978 by President Gerald Ford.

The earliest evidence of the phrase "Black Friday" applied to the day after Thanksgiving in a shopping context suggests that the term originated in Philadelphia, where it was used to describe the heavy & disruptive pedestrian & vehicle traffic that would occur on the day after Thanksgiving. This usage dates to at least 1961. More than twenty years later, as the phrase became more widespread, a popular explanation became that this day represented the point in the year when retailers begin to turn a profit, thus going from being "in the red" to being "in the black".
